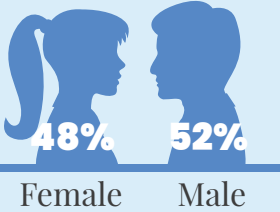

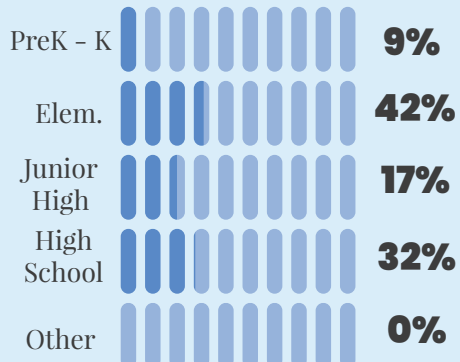

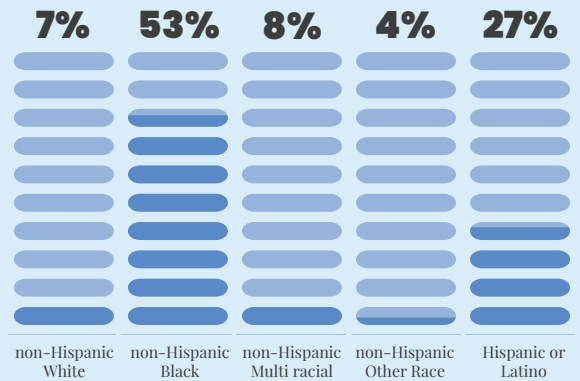

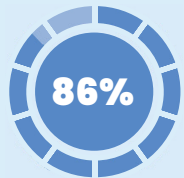

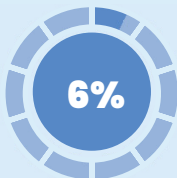

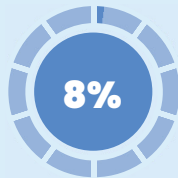
LANGUAGE SPOKEN AT HOME*

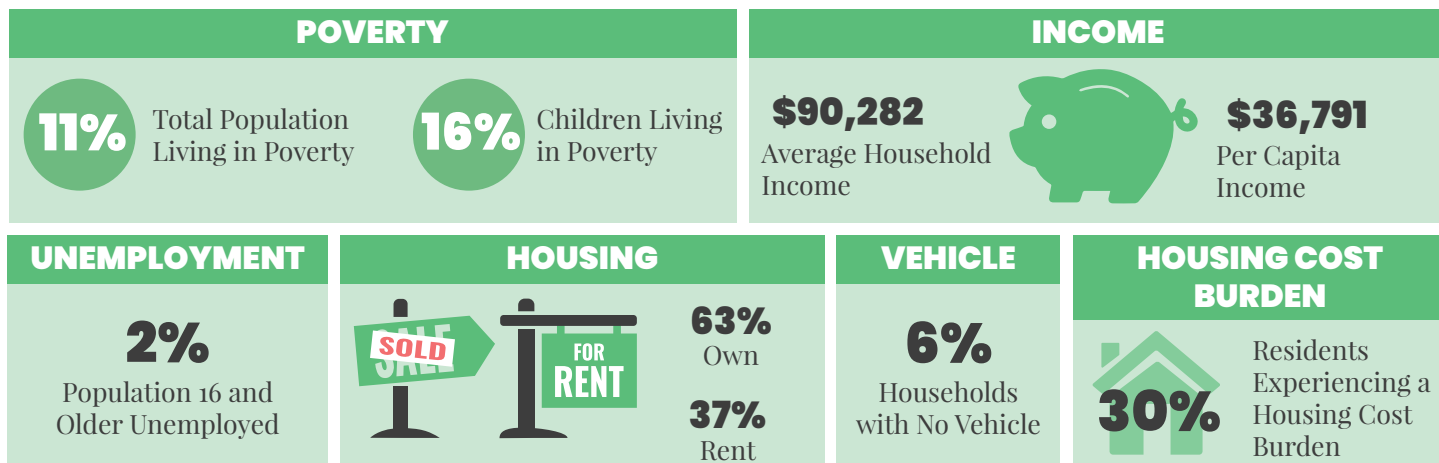

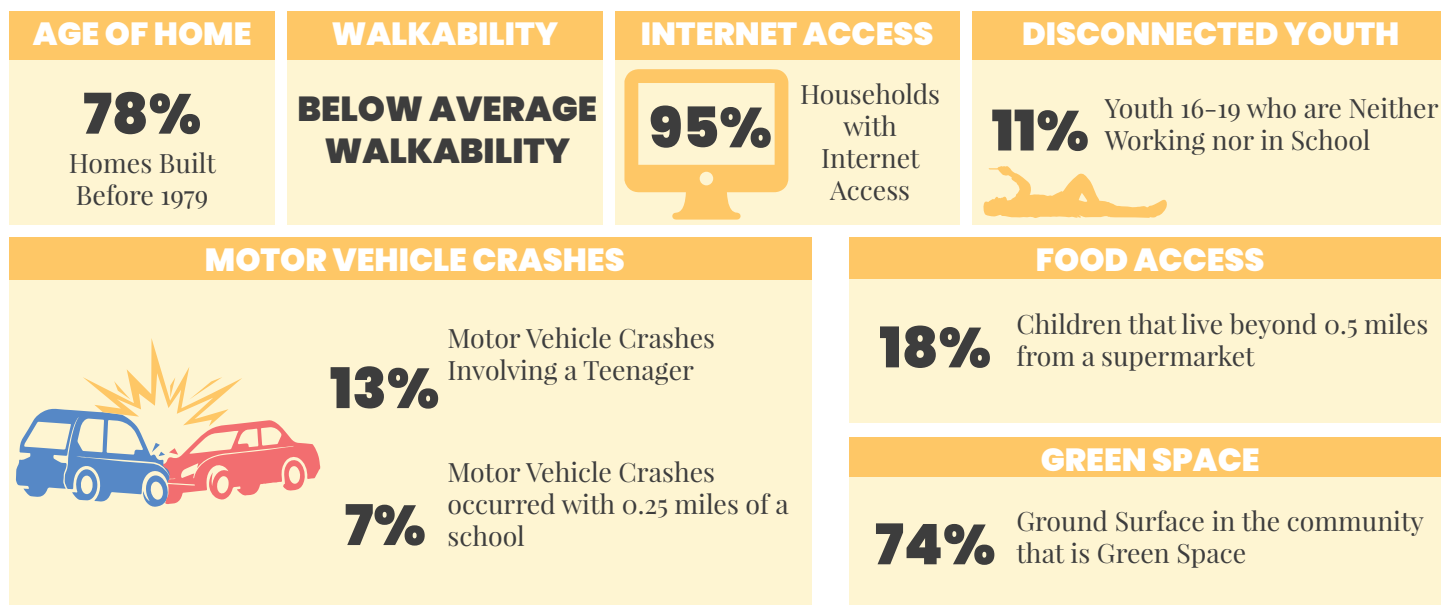

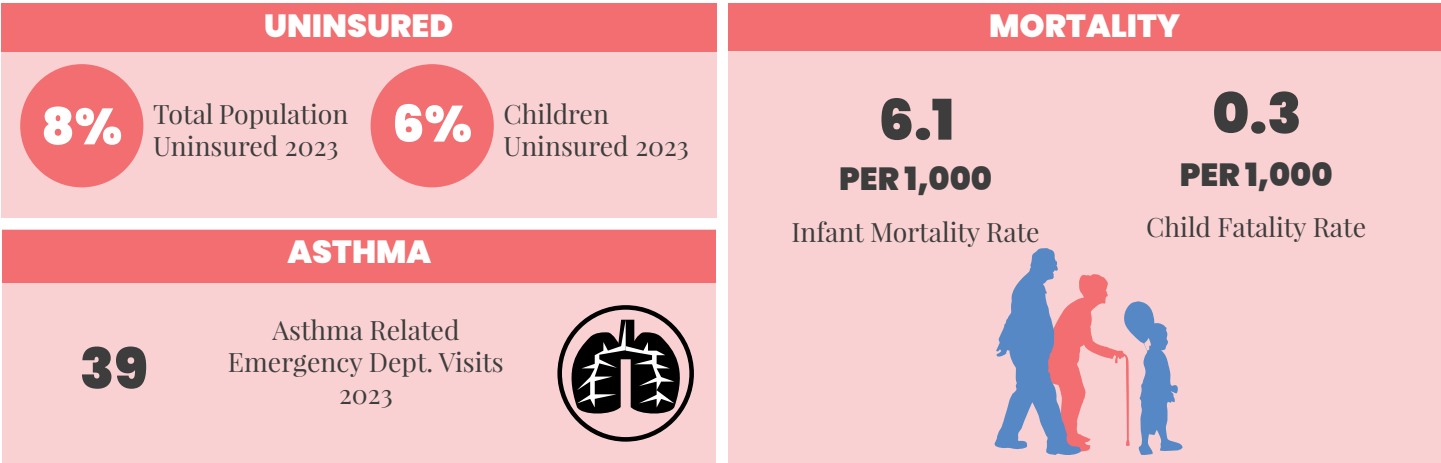
ECONOMIC STABILITY | 2023



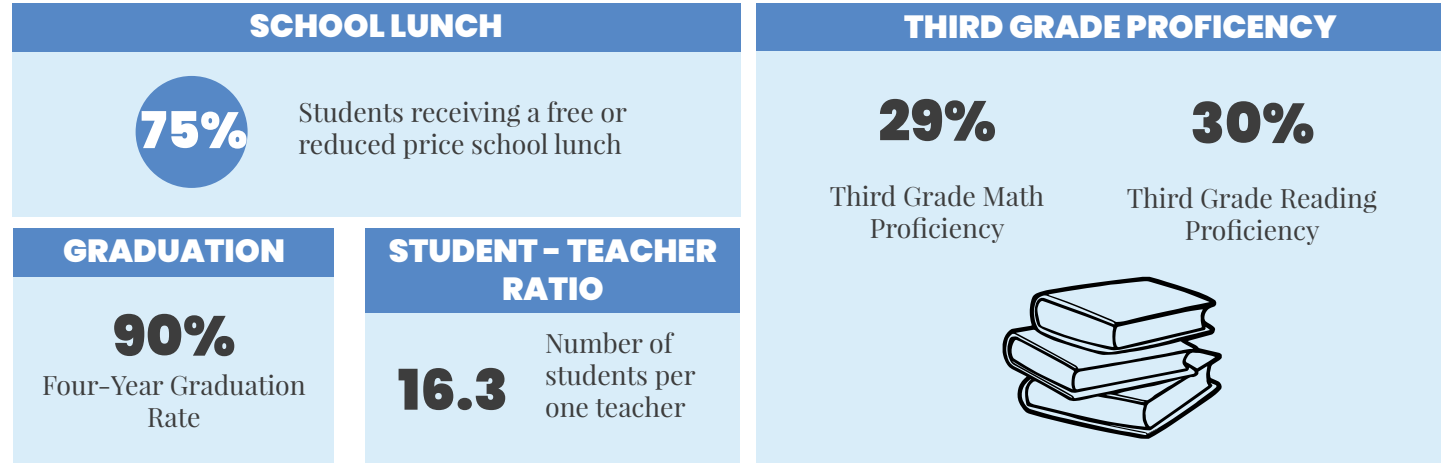
NEIGHBORHOOD & BUILT ENVIRONMENT | 2023

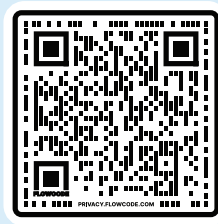
